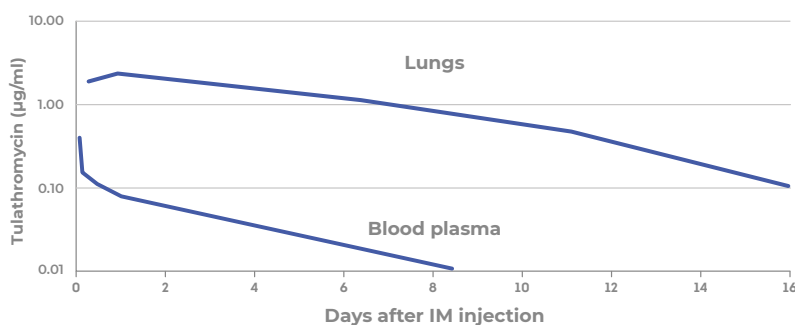
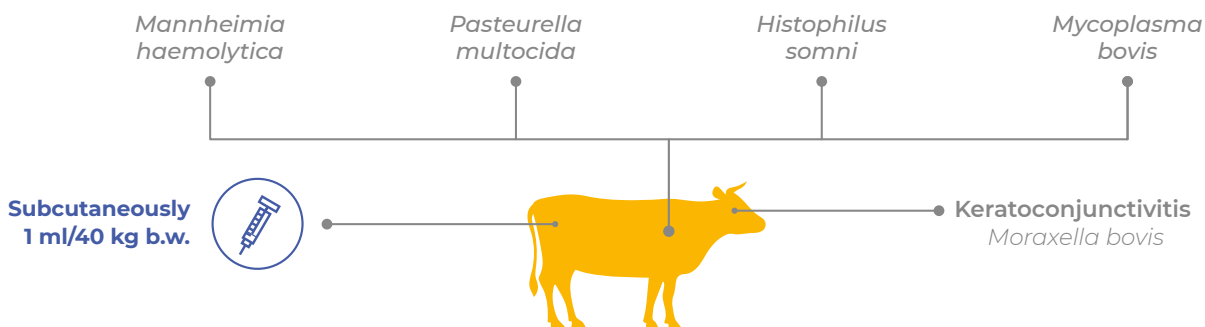
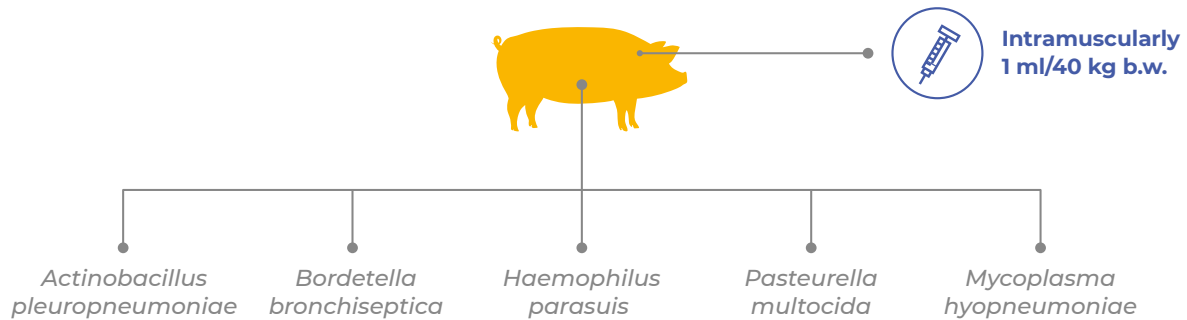

Comparison of Tulaxan concentrations in the lungs and blood plasma after an intramuscular injection of 2.5 mg/kg.

Long-term maintenance of Tulaxan at concentrations significantly above MIC90 indicates a prolonged therapeutic effect against the main bacterial pathogens of respiratory diseases.
